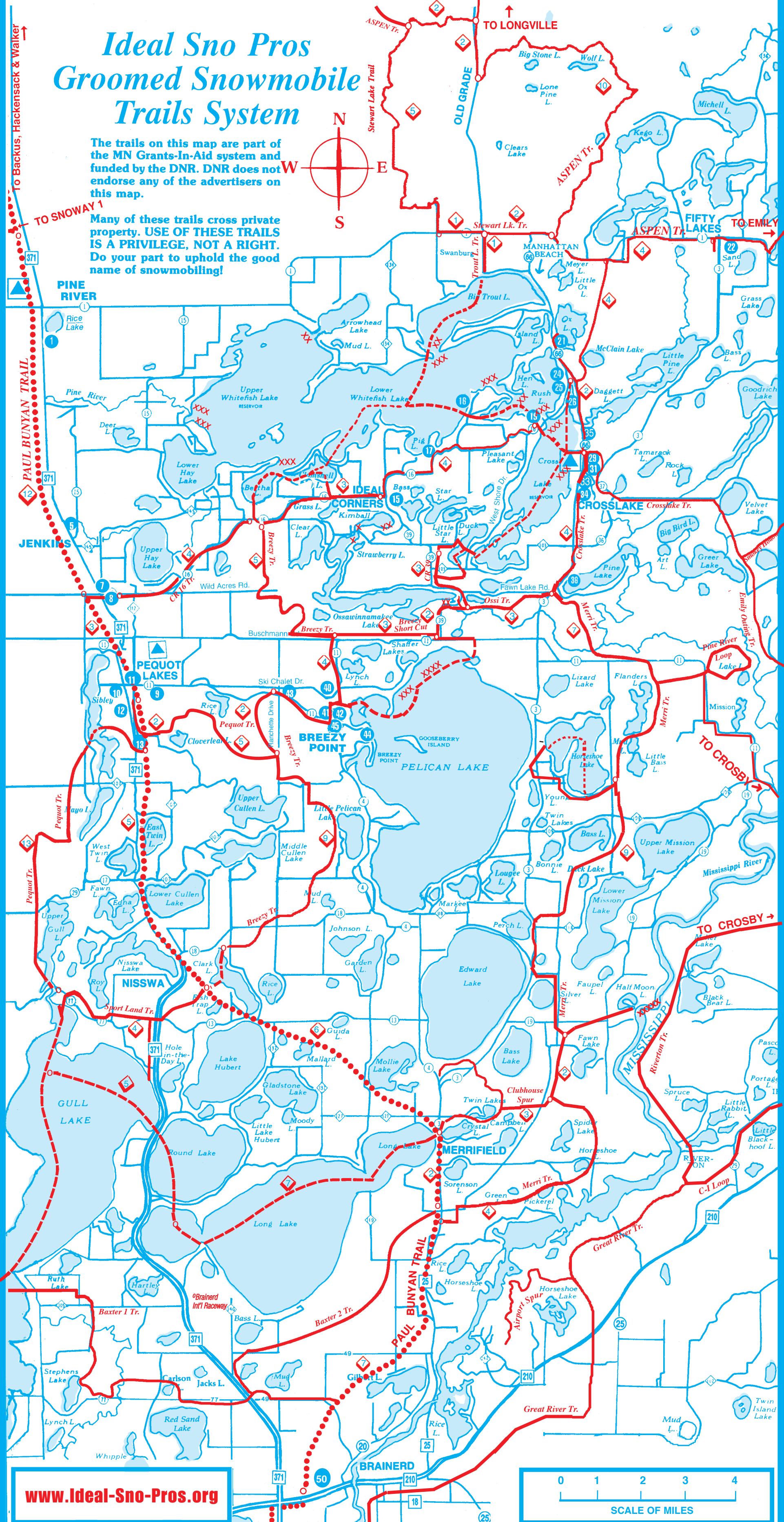
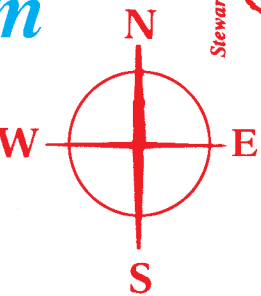

Snowmobile Trail Sticker Alert: In addition to your snowmobile license, a State Trail Sticker is required for all snowmobiles, resident and non-resident alike, being operated on a state or grant-in-aid trail. A 1-year sticker costs \$16 and is good from Nov. 1 to April 30. Stickers can be purchased at any ELS licensing agency or deputy registrar.
